The Sonographer will:

- Conduct limited ultrasound exams for eligible women under the Medical Director's supervision in accordance with established policies and procedures.
- Communicate ultrasound findings with clients.
- Document the delivery of client care in compliance with professional practice standards.
- Provide options counseling to clients.
- Maintain oversight of ultrasound equipment, including monitoring equipment concerns and scheduling needed maintenance.
- Maintain supplies necessary to complete ultrasound scans.
- Participate in updating applicable policies and procedures.

Minimum qualifications include:

- Be a committed Christian who demonstrates an active personal relationship with Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.
- Affirm full agreement with the organization's Mission Statement and Statement of Principles.
- Exhibit a strong commitment and dedication to the pro-life position and sexual purity, never referring or recommending that a woman have an abortion.
- Have a sincere desire to reach out to abortion-vulnerable and abortion-minded women and men.
- Exhibit skill in human relations, written and oral communication, and possess the ability to work in a collaborative setting
- Have two years of clinical experience preferred with an emphasis on obstetrical and gynecological care.
- Respect the authority roles God has placed at the ministry.
- Hold a current Registered Diagnostic Medical Sonographer (RDMS) license in good standing with the American Registry of Diagnostic Medical Sonographers. A Registered Nursing license is highly desirable, but not required.
- Be willing to obtain any training required to demonstrate competency in obstetrical ultrasounds.
